

Academic Honesty Policy Senior Option – Online Classes

Students participating in the Senior Option – Online Classes program must understand and abide by the Academic Honesty Policy. Students are expected to complete their own work for all assignments and exams required by the online school. Academic dishonesty includes, but is not limited to, the following:

Cheating

- Obtaining information from another student during an exam.
- Communicating information to another student during an exam.
- Knowingly allowing another student to copy one's work.
- Offering another person's work as one's own.
- Sharing answers for a take-home exam unless specifically authorized by the instructor.
- Using unauthorized material during an exam or on an assignment.

Plagiarism

Plagiarism is to present as one's own the ideas, words, or creative product of another. Credit must be given to the source for direct quotations, paraphrases, ideas, and facts which are not common knowledge.

Collusion

Collusion occurs when any student knowingly or intentionally helps another student perform an act of academic dishonesty. Collusion in an act of academic dishonesty will be disciplined in the same manner as the act itself.
